A member-based organisation, Quality Scotland was established in 1991 in response to the perceived growing competitive threat facing the Scottish economy nationally and internationally. Its aim was – and remains – to help organisations throughout Scotland achieve and be recognised for Excellence, and in so doing, gain real and sustainable competitive advantage.

From just 14 founding companies, Quality Scotland's members now number over 200. They include blue chips such as Standard Life and the Royal Bank of Scotland, as well as ambitious SMEs and a range of public sector and voluntary organisations. The diversity of our membership highlights the relevance of what we offer to a wide cross-section of the economy. What connects our members is their shared belief in the value of Business Excellence, and their drive and commitment to improve their organisations' performance.

Self-Assessment

The core of Quality Scotland's business revolves around enabling organisations to fully understand how well they are performing, and to identify areas for improvement. As the nation's Business Excellence experts and the National Partner Organisation for EFQM in Scotland (the most widely used Business Excellence Framework in Europe), members benefit from support of a dedicated Account Manager who provides guidance and expertise in implementing business improvement programmes. What's more, our Account Managers are familiar with the use of other business improvement tools and standards like Kaizen, Balanced Scorecard, the Investors in People standard, ISO 9001, lean management techniques and CharterMark and how these can be integrated into a comprehensive programme. By facilitating self-assessment, Quality Scotland can support you in developing and implementing your improvement plans, helping you achieve outstanding performance.

We believe that this type of holistic approach to Business Excellence is fundamental for sustained organisational success, and this belief is backed up by recent research which establishes a strong correlation between Business Excellence and Performance. In particular, it was found that a Business Excellence approach increases an organisation's 'Strategic Agility', in other words its capacity to adapt quickly to change, and in today's fast-paced dynamic economy, this ability is becoming ever more crucial.





Excellence Journey

We encourage organisations to embark on an Excellence Journey, that is, to take a long term perspective with short, medium and long term objectives to achieve Business Excellence. Organisations can choose from various stages of accreditation from Quality Scotland's new Levels of Excellence programme, which includes schemes like Committed to Excellence, Recognised for Excellence and Scottish Awards for Business Excellence. Ultimately, winners of the Scottish Awards for Business Excellence may go forward to the European Quality Awards where they can achieve recognition across Europe and beyond. To achieve accreditation at this level requires an outstanding overall performance, and strong commitment to improvement throughout the organisation.

However, Quality Scotland's approach is about more than awards, it's about adopting long term sustainable business practices which provide real tangible benefits to performance. This is why the Levels of Excellence programme provides thorough and valuable written and face-to-face feedback from our expert assessors- senior business people from different backgrounds that assess your organisation.

Online Tools

Quality Scotland has developed a number of online tools, designed to help the implementation of any self-assessment framework as simple as possible! For organisations that are simply starting out on their Excellence Journey or that have had little experience with business improvement activities- Business Juggler- is an ideal and cost effective tool to focus on those areas that you've never quite had the time to look at- fast!

For a more sophisticated approach, Pathway allows to involve a wide cross-section of your organisation in self-assessment. This will provide impressive remarkable insight into your organisation's strengths and areas for improvement as well as identify action points to incorporate into your improvement plans. Pathway's powerful and advanced charting applications means that you are able to analyse all of the data that you have compiled about your organisation- all with the click of a button!

Sharing Best Practice

Quality Scotland also facilitates benchmarking and networking between its members, allowing them to meet and exchange experiences. For instance, we offer a FREE "Business Matchmaking" service where we will put in contact an organisation that is struggling with a particular business issue with another that has overcome similar problems in the past. Some members have valued these networking opportunities so much, that together, we have gone on to create networking forums such as the Voluntary Sector Network and mentoring programmes to facilitate exchange of best practice between our members.

We also encourage networking opportunities between members through our exciting training and events programmes- these range from specialised courses on Business Excellence and EFQM to Conferences, Learning Journeys and Masterclasses. For instance, at our Leadership Masterclass earlier this year, we provided ample networking opportunities during the course of the day and actively encouraged delegates to stay for a complimentary drink at the bar once the event had finished!
