Lean Six Sigma Statistical Tools 2

This course is normally taken after Statistical Tools 1 and covers further statistical tools

Topics include Hypothesis Tests (t test, Analysis of Variance and Chi-Square Tests), Regression (Simple, Multiple, Binary Logistic), Control Charts (Continuous and Attribute Data Charts) and an introduction to Designed Experiments (Full and Fractional Factorial Designs).

Who should attend?

Participants will usually have completed Foundation Green Belt training and Statistical Tools 1.

What will you gain?

- Practical training on the application of powerful statistical tools to business problems.
- How these tools can enhance your ability to make data driven decisions, validate improvements, characterise processes, present compelling statistical evidence to justify improvements
- A thorough grounding in Minitab software.
- An opportunity to receive input on your project (bring your data!)
- An opportunity to network with other delegates learning about Lean Six Sigma.

Lean Six Sigma modules are run in waves and it is recommended that the Foundation, Statistical Tools and Black Belt modules are taken sequentially. Change Management may be taken at any time and is also available as a stand alone course.
